## Wihlborgs signs a rental agreement for 14,000 m<sup>2</sup> with Schneider Electric Denmark

One month ago Wihlborgs acquired four office properties in Ballerup outside Copenhagen. At the same time Wihlborgs had a negotiation with Schneider Electric Denmark concerning a rental for 14 000 m², i.e. the entire property Lautrupvang 1 in Ballerup.
